

Conflict Mineral Statement

Adesto Technologies recognizes the need to address issues associated with Conflict Minerals and is taking steps to ensure that our products do not contain or utilize minerals from regions in and around the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). To this end Adesto Technologies will not intentionally purchase or support the purchase of Conflict Minerals, nor intentionally add these minerals to our products.

Adesto Technologies seeks to comply with recent US legislation, H.R. 4173, section 15202. Accordingly, we monitor the status and scope of Adesto Technologies' compliance obligations.

Adesto has aligned itself with the EICC GeSI, Conflict-Free Smelters program. Adesto Technologies has been working with all of its suppliers and continues the process of documenting the supply chain. Adesto Technologies has received documentation from subcontractors providing confirmation of the non-use of conflict minerals. Upon your request, we will furnish the EICC GeSI Conflict-Free Smelters worksheet that we have prepared from the information made available to us by our suppliers. The worksheet identifies the conflict minerals that may be used to manufacture and/or may be found in Adesto devices and identified the smelters for those minerals.
