


Driver Setup

Before connecting to a Link2 via USB, you will need to install a driver on your computer. This is a one-time installation to be able to connect to Link2 devices. If you currently use V-Mux Downloader and/or Diagnostics on this computer you already have this driver installed and skip to Wi-Fi Setup.

- 1) Download the driver for your operating system at:

link2dashboard.com and select Link2 software

- 2) With Link2 completely disconnected from the computer, remove its case using a slotted screwdriver to push the side tabs in while pulling out the board. Connect Link2 to your computer with a USB Type-A to Type-B cable.



- 3) If you are prompted to locate the driver file, browse to the location of the downloaded file. Your operating system should finish the installation and recognize the Link2.

Wi-Fi Setup at Station Upload Location

Weldon provides the Definer Wi-Fi configuration tool to connect a Link2 to your wireless network:

- 1) To download Definer go to www.link2dashboard.com and select Link2 software. Download the Definer software for your operating system and run the installer. Follow the on screen prompts to complete installation.
- 2) Connect the USB cable to your computer and Link2 module. Then, launch the Definer software.
- 3) In the menu at the top of the screen, click "Connect to..." to have your computer access the Link2 module settings.
- 4) If you are in range of your wireless network:
 - a. Click the "Wi-Fi" tab
 - b. Click "Search Nearby Networks"
 - c. Select your network from the dropdown list and click "OK".
 - d. In the Security Type drop down, select your network's security type and enter in your passcode (if required)
- 5) If you program the unit outside of the network range:
 - a. Manually enter your network name (network SSID).
 - b. Select your network's security type and type in your passcode (if required)
- 6) Click "Apply".
- 7) The blue light at the center of the Link2 will flash while searching for a connection. When the LED stays lit, the Link2 has successfully connected to your network. Click the disconnect icon. Remove the USB from the Link2 model. Attach the case and plug the Link2 into your harness.
- 8) Wi-Fi setup is complete.
