## **A. Connecting the SM1-USB reader**

1. Locate the USB port on either the back or the front of the computer.



2. Insert the USB connector of the SM1-USB into the USB port.

## **B. Windows 98 / Me**

1. Windows will automatically detect the device ask for the drivers for your USB Smart Card Reader



2. Click "Next" on the Add New Hardware Wizard screen.



3. Select "Search for the best driver for your device (Recommended)" and click "Next"



4. Select "Floppy disk drives" (you may de-select all other options), place your installation diskette in the diskette drive, and click "Next".



5. Click "Next" to confirm the location of the USB Smart Card Reader Driver



6. When Windows has installed the USB Smart Card Reader Driver click "Finish" to complete the installation.


**These instructions are for Microsoft Windows 98 / Me only.**

**Computers running Microsoft Windows 2000 / XP already have PC/SC (smart card base components) provided.**

1. To run the program SCBASE.EXE from the installation diskette click the **Start** button and then click **Run**
2. In the **Run** dialog window, type **A:\scbase** , where "A" is the letter of you floppy disc drive



3. Click "Yes" to install the Microsoft Smart Card Base Components



4. Click "Yes" to the Licence Agreement Screen.

5. Close the "readme – Notepad" using File menu and click "OK" to finish the installation of Microsoft Smart Card Base Components.



6. Click "OK" to proceed and reboot the computer



## C. Windows XP / 2000


1. Windows will automatically detect the device and ask for the drivers for your USB Smart Card Reader



2. Select "Install from a list of specific location (Advanced)" and click "Next"



3. Place your installation diskette in the diskette drive, Select "Search removable media" (you may de-select all other options), and click "Next".




4. Click on Continue anyway to install the SmartMouse USB drivers




5. When Windows has installed the USB Smart Card Reader Driver click "Finish" to complete the installation.

**D. On Windows XP only you need to start the smart card services.**

1. On start menu select Settings... Control Panel... Performance and Maintenance... Administrative Tools... Services



2. Scroll down to Smart card and double click



3. Press Start and change startup type to automatic
4. Press OK to finish installation
