A new type of weighing module for process-weighing applications has been developed to allow simple, fast installation and removal of the load cell, without special equipment. To be introduced at the Powder Bulk Solids Show in Chicago in May, **LeverMount**\* has an exclusive patented design, which allows for safe and easy raising or lowering of the weighed vessel under load, without the need for separate blocks or extremal jacks.

**LeverMount**\* is supplied as a complete assembly with its own staainless steel load cell. Once the tank has been positioned on the sturdy base casting, the removal of two transit bolts allows the load cell itself to act as a lever, raising the top plate of the mount into working position. The procedure is simply reversed when the load cell needs to be removed.

Installation and removal of the load cell can be carried out regardless of whether the tank is empty or full, resulting in significant downtime savings. To ensure durability even in the harshest environments, **LeverMount**\* combines a simple, two-part mount cast stainless steel with a fully welded, stainless steel load cell sealed to IP68. Users have a choice of three single-ended shear beam load cells rated for 1100 lbs., 2200 lbs. or 4400 lbs. – a LeverMount\* and load cell for 11,000 lb. is currently being developed.

**LeverMount**\* can be installed for radial or offset mounting, allowing easy alignment during installation. Lift-off and tilt prevention ensures safety and consistent accuracy. The top

plate is designed for linear and rotational movement to accommodate any misalignment of steelwork, and to prevent errors due to expansion and contraction of the tank.



**Answer:** You may be experiencing interference from your motor starter. The coil in the starter is an electro-magnet, which when energized, attracts a metal plate and moves the contacts. When the starter is de-energized the inductive field of the electro-magnet

collapses and energy in the form of interference (noise) can be sent down the supply cables. This noise could cause problems with any type of electronic device including your Speedswitches. A simple and inexpensive solution is to install some type of suppressor across the coil terminals of the motor starter. An R-C network of 100  $\Omega$  - 0.1  $\mu$ F and 250 vac works well for most applications. This device will prevent most of the noise from entering the power lines. It is actually good practice to install these devices across all inductive loads, such as solenoids, alarm horns, relays and contactors. Their cost is very little and their benefit is potentially huge. 📲
