#### **Certified Wooden Pallets for Export**

Are you aware of the new customs regulation regarding the use of certified pallets for exporting? The wood must be treated by at least one, or a combination of approved international measures. The two most commonly used measures are the HT (heat treated) and MB (methyl bromide fumigation).


To comply with HT, the center of the wood must reach at least 56°C for a minimum of 30 minutes. Kettle Dried (KD) or CPI (Chemical Pressure Impregnation) are valid treatments considered under HT. For pallets to be in compliance with the new regulation, the wood must be

stenciled or impregnated with the international symbol (IPPC symbol) letter



code, a number, and the abbreviation of the treatment. Customs authorities will return or destroy any merchandise that does not comply with the new regulation.

All 4B exports are in compliance with this new regulation.

The SPS buckets have the same design and fill characteristics as the larger SJ bucket, but offer a wider range of sizes. The bucket is manufactured from 3mm pressed steel (stainless steel available), with a wear lip option. Examples of use include sand, cement, coal, aggregates, powders, fertilizer, etc.

Traditional bucket elevators use large and expensive fabricated or cast nylon / steel buckets which can have inherent flaws and are expensive, heavy, bulky, and paired with poor design and fill characteristics.

**QUESTION:** What are my best options for monitoring the temperature of the bearings in my plant?

**ANSWER:** Although there are several technologies available to sense temperature, some are better suited to plant bearing temperature monitoring applications than others. The guide below outlines the differences between the three main technologies.

The temperature sensors must be connected to other devices which translate the sensor information into actual temperatures (°F or °C) so that plant operators

and maintenance personnel are able to see the individual bearing temperature.
