PCI Race Radios Puts Icom IC-F121 to the Ultimate Test



How durable are Icom radios? Tough enough to withstand breathtaking 40-mile-per-hour motorsport crashes. How reliable are Icom radios? So reliable that the No. 1 off-road racing communications company uses Icom radios (the IC-F3011 and IC-F121 series) in the vehicle communications systems it designs for events like the Baja 500 and Baja 1000.

Long Beach, Calif.-based PCI Race Radios, the foremost authority on building and maintaining radio systems for extreme motorsport races, has more than 25 years in the off-road racing industry. The company designs specialized two-way communications systems for race vehicles as well as systems for motorcycles/quads, support cars, and pit crews.

Not only does PCI Race Radios design communications systems, it also puts its own products to the ultimate test by racing in events like the Baja 1000. Company teams have scored five Baja 1000 wins and numerous class championships over the years.

"The bottom line is that communications are very important," says Scott Steinberger, owner and president of PCI Race Radios. "It is important for safety as well as race coordination," he says.

Teams use two-way radio for communicating between the race vehicle and the support vehicle and pit crews. Two-way radio is also essential for

communicating via the Weatherman relay to report an emergency or ask for help.

In many cases, reliable communications can make the difference between a DNF and a successful finish.

When designing its in-vehicle communication systems, PCI Race Radios faced the obvious challenge of finding a two-way radio capable of withstanding continuous jarring motion. It also considered the radio's range and the quality of its selective receiver due to high airtime saturation and interference during the race.


