A report is required for each of your products qualified to the subject military specification. The original data must be retained by your company and is to be made available to authorized government representatives upon request. Please coordinate your summary with your government Quality Assurance Representative (QAR) and submit it directly to us in time to arrive by April 30, 2007.

Because we are held responsible for the accuracy and currency of this QPL, please let us know if your company discontinues production of the products listed above. No changes are to be made in the design and construction of the products qualified without approval of the Defense Supply Center, Columbus.
