

QF 8200-D – INSTRUCTIONS FOR IMPORTS: RETURNING EAR-CONTROLLED HARDWARE FOR REPAIR or REPLACEMENT

Teledyne Employee

Before you import EAR-Controlled RMA hardware send this form to person who will send the goods.

Persons Outside of USA

Follow instructions below when shipping items to Teledyne Storm Microwave.

Utilize the original sales order that the items were received on.

A. Include a Commercial Invoice that contains the following information in English language:

1	Part number as listed on sales order
2	Description of item as listed on sales order
3	Quantity to be returned
4	Country of origin USA (unless item is otherwise marked)
5	Full value of goods being returned in U.S. dollars as listed on the sales order

B. Country of Origin Marking Requirements

U.S. Customs laws (19 CFR 134) require that every article of foreign origin (or its container) imported into the United States must be marked "**Made in** [*insert country of origin*]" in a conspicuous place as legibly, indelibly and permanently as the nature of the article permits. If a part cannot be marked, then the part's container must be marked. This container IS NOT the outer shipping container.

C. Advance Notification

Prior to delivery, send Commercial Invoice to your Sales Representative or other contact and Teledyne Storm Microwave's Import Administrator –
