# 1.1 General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT186A "full pack" plastic package. This "series D" triac balances the requirements of commutation performance and gate sensitivity. The "very sensitive gate" "series D" is intended for interfacing with low power drivers including microcontrollers.

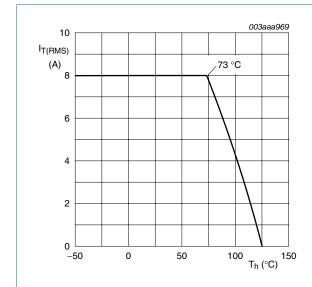
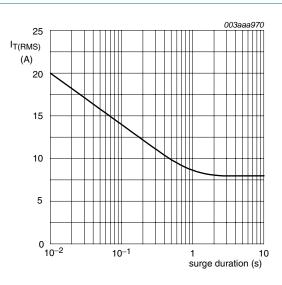


Fig 1. RMS on-state current as a function of heatsink temperature; maximum values

Fig 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

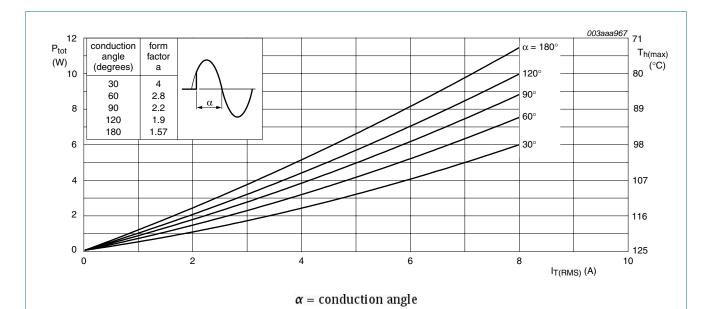


Fig 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values

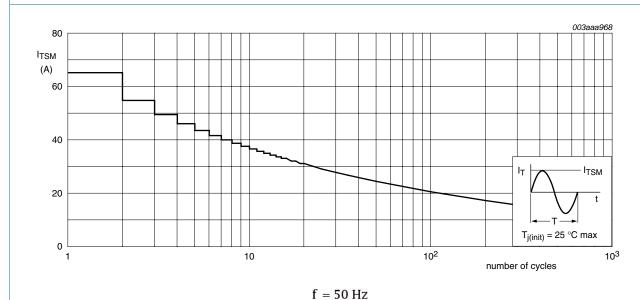
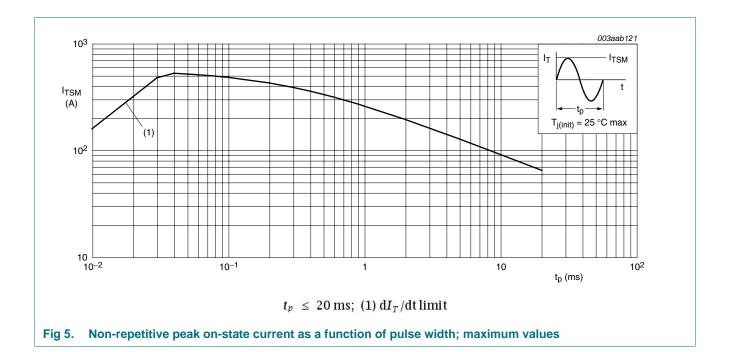


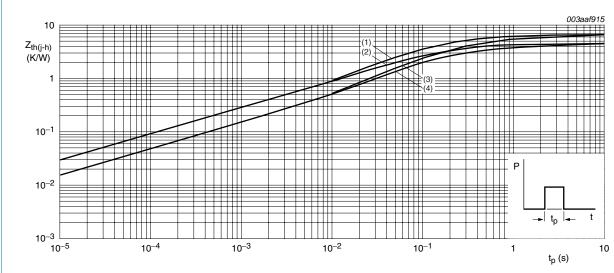
Fig 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values

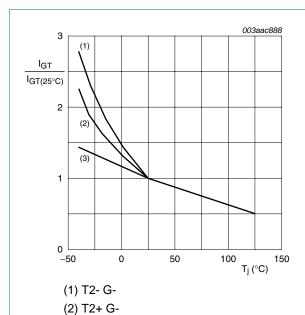

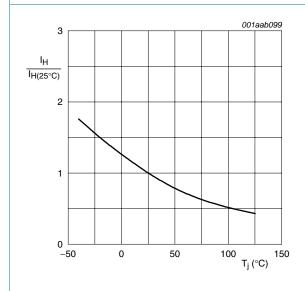


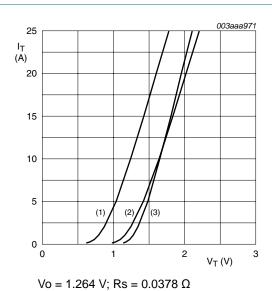


Normalized gate trigger current as a function of Fig 7. junction temperature

Fig 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage

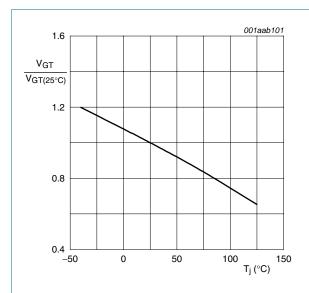


Fig 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature

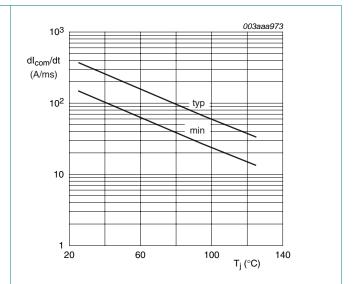
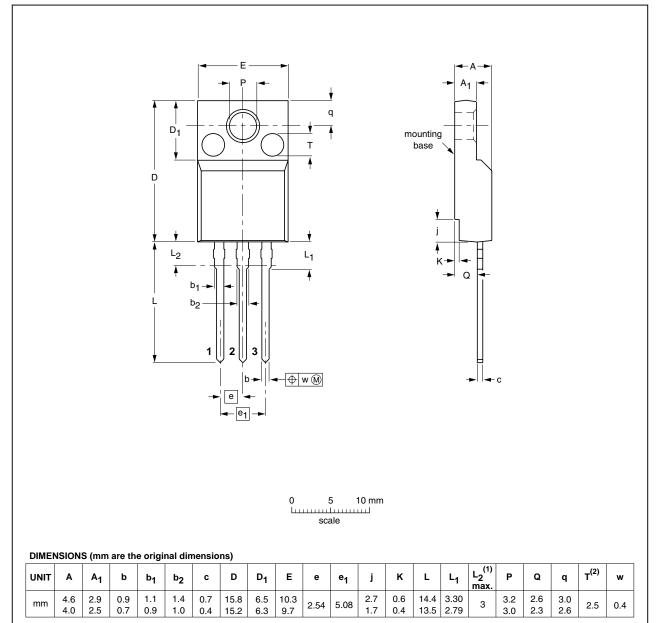


Fig 12. Rate of change of commutating current as a function of junction temperature; typical and minimum values
