Product data sheet

General description 1.

The 74AUP1G158 is a single 2-input multiplexer which select data from two data inputs (I0 and I1) under control of a common data select input (S). The state of the common data select input determines the particular register from which the data comes. The output (Y) presents the selected data in the complement (inverted) form.

Schmitt trigger action at all inputs makes the circuit tolerant to slower input rise and fall times across the entire V_{CC} range from 0.8 V to 3.6 V.

This device ensures a very low static and dynamic power consumption across the entire V_{CC} range from 0.8 V to 3.6 V.

This device is fully specified for partial power-down applications using I_{OFF}. The I_{OFF} circuitry disables the output, preventing the damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.









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




Fig 10. Package outline SOT363 (SC-88)

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


Fig 11. Package outline SOT886 (XSON6)

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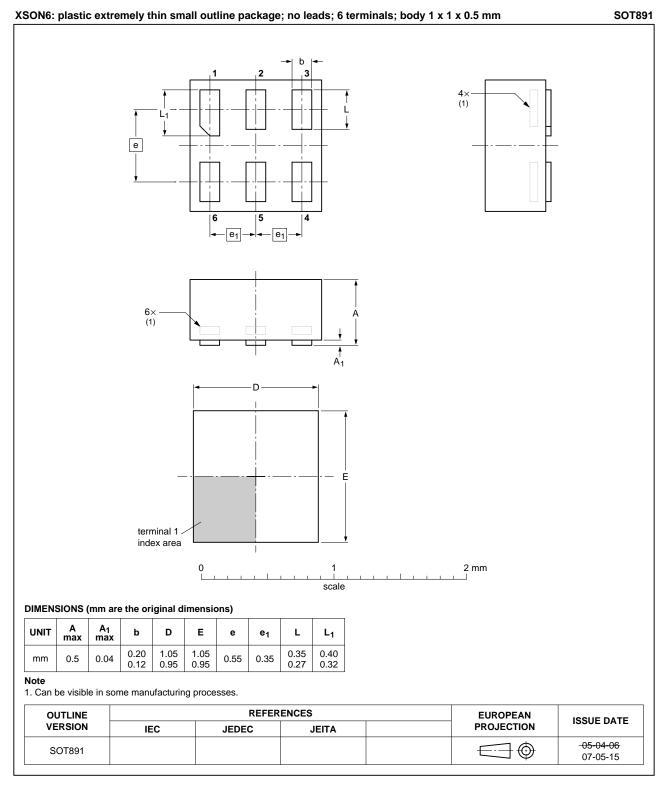



Fig 12. Package outline SOT891 (XSON6)

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
