



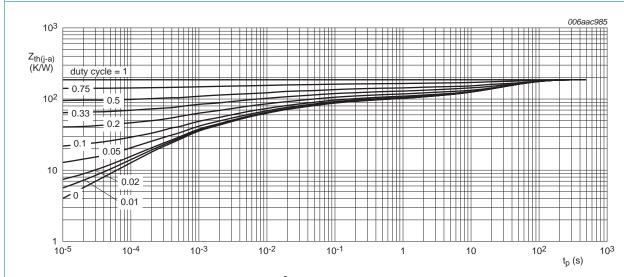

Fig 2. Transient thermal impedance from junction to ambient as a function of pulse duration; typical values




FR4 PCB, mounting pad for collector 1 cm²



Fig 4. DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values





Fig 5. Base-emitter voltage as a function of collector current; typical values





Fig 7. Base-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values





Fig 8. Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values


Fig 9. Collector-emitter equivalent on-resistance as a function of collector current; typical values


