




Fig.3. Maximum non-repetitive rms forward current.  $I_F = f(t_p)$ ; sinusoidal current waveform;  $T_j = 150^{\circ}C$  prior to surge with reapplied  $V_{RWM}$ .




Fig.5. BY359-1500 forward characteristic  $I_F = f(V_F)$ ; parameter  $T_j$ 




Fig.4. Transient thermal impedance  $Z_{th} = f(t_p)$ 





Fig.6. BY359-1500S forward characteristic  $I_F = f(V_F)$ ; parameter  $T_j$
